Precautionary Statements – Prevention:

Keep only in original packaging. Wear protective gloves, protective clothing and eye or face protection.

Do not breath dust/fume/gas/mist/vapors/spray.

Wash face, hands and any exposed skin thoroughly after handling.

Precautionary Statements – Response:

Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician.

IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.

IF ON SKIN (or hair): Remove/Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water/shower. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing.

IF SWALLOWED: Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting unless directed to do so by medical personnel. Drink a cupful of milk or water.

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Section 4. First Aid Measures

Eye contact: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.

Skin contact: Take off immediately all contaminated clothing and wash it before reuse.

Inhalation: Get medical attention or advice if you feel unwell.

Ingestion: Rinse mouth. Immediately drink 1 glass of water. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention or advice if you feel unwell.

Section 5. Firefighting Measures

5.3. Advice for firefighters

As in any fire, wear self-contained breathing apparatus and suitable protective clothing including gloves and eye/face protection.

Section 6. Accidental Release Measures

6.1 Personal precautions, protective equipment and emergency procedures

Ensure adequate ventilation. Keep people away from and upwind of spill/leak. Avoid inhalation, ingestion and contact with skin and eyes. When workers are facing concentrations above the exposure limit they must use appropriate certified respirators. Ensure clean-up is conducted by trained personnel only. Refer to protective measures listed in sections 7 and 8.

6.2 Environmental precautions

Dilute with plenty of water. Do not allow to enter drainage system, surface or ground water.

6.3 Methods and material for containment and cleaning up

Stop leak if safe to do so. Contain spillage, and then collect with non-combustible absorbent material, (e.g. sand, earth, diatomaceous earth, vermiculite) and place in container for disposal according to local / national regulations (see section 13). For large spills, dike spilled material or otherwise contain material to ensure runoff does not reach a waterway.

Section 7. Handling and storage

7.1 Precautions for safe handling

Measures to prevent fire and explosions:

The product is not flammable. Keep away from heat, hot surfaces, sparks, open flames and other ignition sources. No smoking. Take precautionary measures against static discharges. Use explosion-proof electrical, ventilating or lighting equipment. Use non-sparking tools.

Measures required to protect the environment:

For environmental exposure controls see subsection 8.

Advices on general occupational hygiene:

Handle in accordance with good industrial hygiene and safety practice. Keep away from food, drink and animal feeding stuffs. Do not mix with other products unless advised by Diversey. Wash hands before breaks and at the end of workday. Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Avoid contact with skin. Do not breathe spray. Use only with adequate ventilation. See chapter 8, Exposure controls / Personal protection.

7.2 Conditions for safe storage, including any incompatibilities

Store in accordance with local and national regulations. Store in a well-ventilated place. Store in a closed container. Keep only in original packaging. Keep from freezing. Keep cool. Keep away from heat and direct sunlight.
